WHITE WINES

Le Havre de Paix Cotes de Gascogne 2017, Pays d'Oc, France | £6.90

This blend of Colombard, Sauvignon Blanc and Gros Manseng is delicious. It is steely and zesty with refreshing tangy grapey/grapefruit freshness. Subtle hints of spice and pear mingle with peachiness on the finish.

Palazzi Pinot Grigio/Garganega 2018, Veneto Italy | £7.20

Pale straw yellow in colour, this is a lightly aromatic dry Pinot Grigio with ripe citrus and baked apple characters. It is fresh, crisp and easy to drink, with soft, lightly honeyed fruit. It's certainly more interesting than your basic Pinot Grigio!

Long Country Sauvignon Blanc 2018, Central Valley, Chile | £7.50

A nice straightforward Sauvignon Blanc with a lovely nose, flowers, herbs and citrus, followed by taste of herbs and citrus. A decent wine and very good with food.

Leaping Hound Chenin Viognier 2018, Paarl, South Africa | £7.90

Vibrant and aromatic with delicious subtle perfumed aromas with white peach and hints of jasmine on the nose. On the palate it has tight, white, fleshy stone fruit and fresh apricot flavours that balances the sandy texture.

Taringi Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand 2018 | £9.90

A classic nose of gooseberries and fresh cut grass. The mid weight palate is filled with ripe tropical fruits and a hint of oiliness.

Terra Occitana Chardonnay, Jacques Charlet, France 2017 | £9.90

Soft and generous Chardonnay from the *pays d'Oc* with citrus and floral aromas and ripe greengage fruit.

Gayda Organic Viognier 2017, Languedoc, France | £10.50

Pale lemon gold with an explosive nose. Lovely flavours of apricot, peach and acacia blossom give way to an elegance and freshness balancing perfectly the richness of the grape.

Three Choirs 'Coleridge Hill' 2017, Gloucs, England | £11.00

A soft floral aroma of elderflower and nettle combined with a hint of peaches leads to an elegant and lively crisp dry wine.

La Linda Viognier 2018, Maipu, Argentina | £11.00

Full of peach and apricot fruit with a refreshingly balanced, crisp, pungent and aromatic wine with bags of biting acidity.

WHITE WINES

Asorei Albarino 2016, Rias Baixas, Spain | £12.50

Most definitely the most delicious Albarino that we have ever listed. Lees ageing for six months gives the wine terrific vibrance and freshness whilst retaining those delicious citrus and peach like fruit. The most perfect wine for meaty shellfish.

One Chain, The Courtesan Riesling 2018, Clare Valley, France | £13.50

A great example of what Clare Valley Riesling can be. Mouthwatering lime and elderflower with grapefruit and quince notes and a vibrant acidity.

Sancerre Domaine Cherrier 2017, Loire Valley, France | £15.50

Traditionally made Sancerre at its best with highly minerally fruit and flavours of gooseberry and wet grass.

Chablis Alan Geoffroy 2018, France | £16.50

This has everything you'd expect from a Chablis: dry, restrained and delicately laced with flavour and minerality.

Domaine Vincent 2017 Vatan Pouilly Fumé, France | £23.00

Light Citrus and citrus peel on the nose, with some faint floral hints. Medium mouth feel. Delightful rounded flavor with mild Citrus and acidity.

Pouilly-Fuisse 2017 Domaine des Sansonnets, France | £24.00

Hazlenuts and toast lead the nose and palate, alongside almonds, apple fruit and intense tropicality. Wonderful and crisp balancing acidity.

Chablis 1^{er} Cru Beauroy 2017, Alain Geoffroy | £24.00

This is a very classic style, with aromas of white flowers, tinged with honey and lemon and a rich, rounded palate with those benchmark flinty notes.

Domaine Schlumberger 2015, Riesling, Alsace Grand Cru Searing | £25.00

A bold and elegant nose with citrus fruit, white flowers that builds in complexity. The dry palate is full and redolent with fleshy citrus, stone and orchard fruits with added floral notes and a clean minerality. Vivacious and long.

RED WINES

Campo Azafran 2018, Tempranillo/Syrah/Boal, Spain | £6.90

Ruby red colour with violet tints showing its youth. On the nose it is fresh and elegant with characteristic aromas of cherry and red fruits typical of this variety. Light, harmonic and round on the palate with soft tannins.

Santa Lucia Merlot 2018, Central Valley, Chile | £7.00

Fruity and rounded with spicy notes, cherries, blackcurrants and small red berry jam.

Long Country Cabernet Sauvignon 2017, Central Valley, Chile | £7.50

Great value Chilean Merlot - a good wine rack-filler and party season saviour! Ripe red fruits give way to some plum and prune flavours. Soft, supple and very drinkable indeed.

Sierra Alta Malbec 2018, Mendoza, Argentina | £8.50

This well balanced Malbec certainly offers a perfect balance between flavour and texture. Flavours of black cherry, ripe plum and hints of chocolate over supple tannins.

Native Carignan 2018, Pays de l'Herault, France | £9.00

This wine has a wonderful lightness, but is nonetheless packed with flavour - a result of being the product of 30-year-old grape vines. Brambly fruit, black cherry and blackcurrant abound.

Terra Occitana Pinot Noir 2016, Jacques Charlet, France | £9.90

A light and clean wine with juicy red berry fruit and a wonderfully refreshing palate.

Lopez de Haro Crianza Rioja 2016, Spain | £10.50

Smooth creamy oak sits alongside bright berry fruit and a note of earthiness. In the mouth it is soft, expressive and elegant, combining a fruity character with the notes lent by the cask, in perfect balance.

Castelsina Chianti Riserva, 2014, Tuscany, Italy | £11.50

Made predominately from Sangiovese, the Castelsina Riserva is a classic, clean, refreshing style of wine. It's lively with floral, cherry and small red berry fruit and dusty tannins on the nose and palate.

The Opportunist Shiraz 2017, McLaren Vale, Australia | £11.90

A deep, inviting crimson black with an intense cassis, plum and bramble nose. Rich, voluptuous and silky on the palate with creamy black fruits and a little savoury smokiness from oak.

The Pugilist Cabernet Sauvignon 2017, McLaren Vale, Australia | £11.90

Rugged and powerful, yet also elegant and balanced. The wine is deep and generous with blackcurrants, plums and wood spice on the pallet. The finish is long, silky and smooth.

RED WINES

Scotto Old Vine Zinfandel 2016, Lodi, California | £11.90

A nose of deep dark fruits and bitter chocolate leads to a full palate of spices and toffee. Smooth tannins and gently clean acidity leads to a pleasing finish.

Panorama Series Roaix, Cotes du Rhone Villages, Caves de Rasteau, France | £12.90

A good Cotes du Rhone showing classic spice with background flavours of smoke and leather from the Syrah.

Chateau Pont de Pierre, St Emilion, Bordeaux, France | £13.90

Rich and with some weight showing classic savoury notes of Cabernet Franc. Earth, foliage and cigar box meet dark fruit and cedar and last well on the pleasing finish.

Horizon de Bichot Pinot Noir 2017, Burgundy, France | £15.90

From Maison Albert Bichot of Burgundy fame, comes this Pinot Noir made from grapes grown in Limoux. This wine is fruit-forward, showing juicy cherry on the palate, with a herbal overtone.

Donjon de Lamarque, Haut Medoc, 2012, Bordeaux, France | £16.90

A ripe, fleshy fruit centre - notes of mulberry and blackcurrant abound on the nose and the palate. Cedar and vanilla oak flavours soften the sinewy tannic structure.

Luigi Bosca ' Los Miradores' Malbec 2016, Uco Valley, Argentina | £23.00

Deep shades of violet in its colour, this wine is brooding, seductive and elegant. With full and ripe flavours of plum and quince, a hint of spice and a rich chocolatey finish, this is a thoroughly enjoyable, grown up wine.

Badine de la Patache, Pomerol 2015, Bordeaux, France | £28.00

A wine which exhibits rich soft plummy fruit you expect from a good Merlot dominated Bordeaux. Depth is contributed by notes of dark chocolate and mocha, and slight fine grained soft tannins.

Celestino Pecci Brunello di Mondalcino, DOCG, Italy | £43.00

Rich ruby red in colour with an attractive garnet hue; spicy, intense and persistent in the nose, perfectly integrated with the large barrels used for ageing. An altogether very harmonious wine, tasty and well-structured on the palate.

SPARKLING AND ROSE WINES

Sparkling

Prosecco Le Dolci Colline Spumante, Veneto, Italy | £10.00

'Le Dolci Colline' has everything that you would expect from a really good Prosecco -superb freshness, a nice frothy mousse, wonderful fresh apples on the nose and a smooth rounded taste profile that has just the right balance between fruit and acidity.

Prosecco Le Dolci Colline Rose Spumante, Veneto, Italy | £10.00

Light and soft with notes of cherry, grapefruit and citrus. A delightfully appealing fizz with balanced red berry fruit and gentle acidity.

Cremant de Limoux Brut, Tholomies, France | £12.00

The Chenin and Chardonnay grapes bring texture and balance, with the Chardonnay also providing the fine bubbles. The Chenin adds vivacity, and enhances the crémant's impressive longevity.

Boschendal Grand Pavilion Brut Rose, South Africa | £14.00

A stunningly created South African pink sparkling wine made from mostly Chardonnay and Merlot grapes. The end result is a sparkling wine with splendid red-fruit flavours and a refreshing finish.

Wiston Estate Brut, NV South Downs, England | £28.00

A cuvée of Pinot Noir, Pinot Meunier and Chardonnay based complex, toasty, savoury fizz with fine bubbles, lots of yeasty, bready autolysis and a bone dry, tapering finish.

Sparkling (20cl)

Dolci Colliene Prosecco 20cl | £4.00

Superb freshness, a nice frothy mousse, wonderful fresh apples on the nose and a smooth rounded taste profile that has just the right balance between fruit and acidity.

Champagne

Champagne Georges de Roualet NV France | £23.00

Classically made Champagne: a blend of Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier. The Pinot Meunier gives body and roundness while the Pinot Noir adds rich fruit and a mouth filling style. A lively mousse, fresh balanced taste and delicacy consistently display in this house style.

Georges de Roualet Brut Champagne, France | £26.00

A lively mousse, fresh balanced taste and delicacy consistently display in this house style.

Georges de Roualet Premier Cru Rose Brut Champagne, France | £32.00

A classic style of rose Champagne filled with raspberry, strawberry and underlying citrus fruit. The palate is light, clean and very fresh. Delicious.

Grande Reserve, Premier Cruu, Champagne Pierre Mignon | £32.00

A crisp, well balanced champagne with citrus hints on the nose overlaid with touches of brioche and yeastiness. The palate is fresh, clean and lively with a creamy mousse and long finish.

Rosé Wines

Dea del Mare Pinot Grigio Blush 2018, Italy | £7.00

The pink hue comes from the brief contact with the darker skins of the Pinot grape as they ripen in late Autumn. Lychee aromas on the nose. Crisp and refreshing taste, lingering with raspberry sorbet flavours.

Pierre et Papa Rose, Pays d'Oc, France | £8.50

A light, refreshing Rosé bursting with red fruits, a perfect balance of roundness and length which makes for an easy drinking wine for all seasons.

Dessert Wines

Chateau Poulvere, Monbazillac, France (37.5cl) | £10.00

This scented golden hued wine is fantastic Sauternes lookalike from just south west of Bergerac. It is soft and sweet but marmalade and honey. Great with cheese or fruit based desserts.

Sauternes, Reserve Dulong (50cl) | £12.50

A light sweet style that is great introduction to Sauternes. Light apricot and honey notes with racy acidity to balance the sweetness.

Port Wines

Churchill's Reserve Port, Portugal | £19.00

Youthful, fruity and well balanced and delightfully easy to drink with layers of sweetish blackcurrant fruit.

Quinta de la Rosa Late Bottled Vintage, Portugal (50cl) | £20.00

A classic blend of Touriga Nacional, Touriga Franca and Tinta Roriz, this retrained LBV has flavours of dark fruit, spice, a slightly mineral finish.
